RE: Court Operations During Government Shutdown

In the occurrence of a federal government shutdown, the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Arizona will remain open and continue court operations. The court will continue to accept new case filings, receive, and process documents and fees, and hear matters. The Case Management/Electronic Case Filing System (CM/ECF) and the Electronic Self-Representation (eSR) System will remain functional for electronic filings. Public service counters and customer service lines will operate during regular business hours.

Updates to the Judges' hearing calendars and the 341 meeting of creditor calendars will continue to be accessible on the court's website. Pay.gov will stay available for online transactions.

Attorneys, legal representatives, and involved parties are advised to closely monitor their cases should the presiding Judge issue any orders regarding deadline extensions or continued hearings.

In the event circumstances change, the Court will provide notice of any changes to scheduled hearings and service levels.
